



SIGN SIZE SHALL BE THAT DESIGNATED IN THE "MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES" (MUTCD) FOR CONVENTIONAL ROADS.

THE 6-FT LATERAL OFFSET SHOWN FOR RURAL ROADS MAY BE REDUCED TO NO LESS THAN 2 FT ON LOW-VOLUME ROADS (ADT <400) IF ROADSIDE FEATURES SUCH AS TERRAIN, SHRUBBERY, AND/OR TREES PREVENT NORMAL INSTALLATION.

STOP SIGNS *(R1-1) SHOULD BE LOCATED 6 FT TO 50 FT FROM THE INTERSECTING PAVEMENT EDGE AND AS CLOSE AS PRACTICAL TO THE INTERSECTION WHILE PROVIDING MAXIMUM VISIBILITY. IF STOP SIGN VISIBILITY IS RESTRICTED, A STOP AHEAD SIGN SHALL

TIMBER, OR STEEL.

BE INSTALLED IN ADVANCE OF THE STOP SIGN. SEE MUTCD.

POSTS FOR TRAFFIC SIGNS SHALL BE EITHER 4"X4" S4S TREATED
